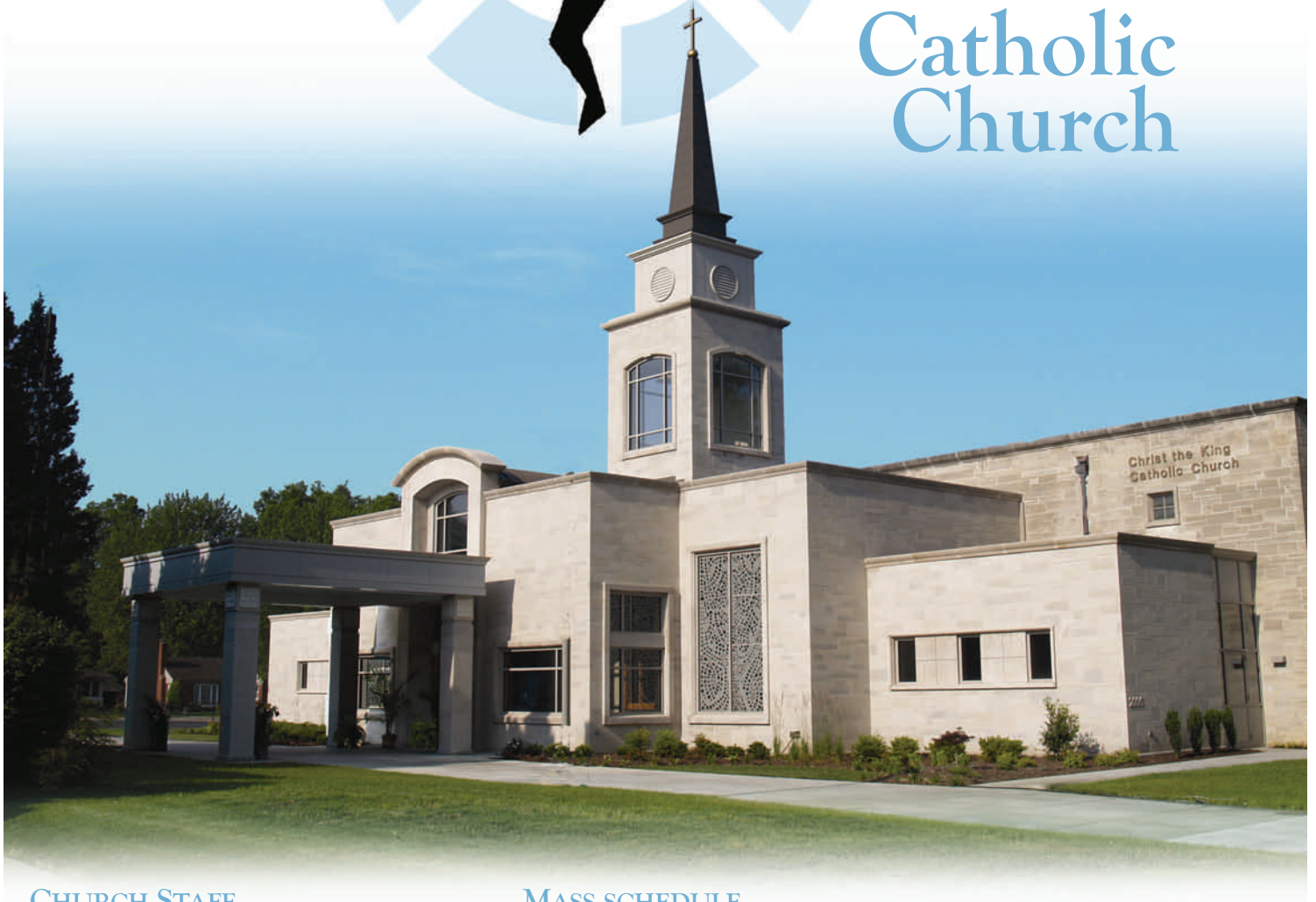

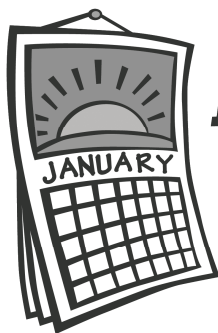

A REMINDER

Private school/home school deduction. This deduction is available for individuals who have a dependent who is enrolled (K-12) in a private school or is homeschooled. If the taxpayer incurs any costs for tuition, fees, computer software, textbooks, or school supplies, they are eligible for a \$1,000 deduction per qualifying child. If married filing separately, a dependent may be claimed only once by one parent.

HOSPITAL VISITS

Our Camillus Ministry will visit anyone in the hospital provided we know they are there. We call the hospitals daily, however, if someone has entered through Emergency or does not designate a parish, they will not be on the list for Christ The King. So please let us know if someone is in the hospital so we can visit them.
