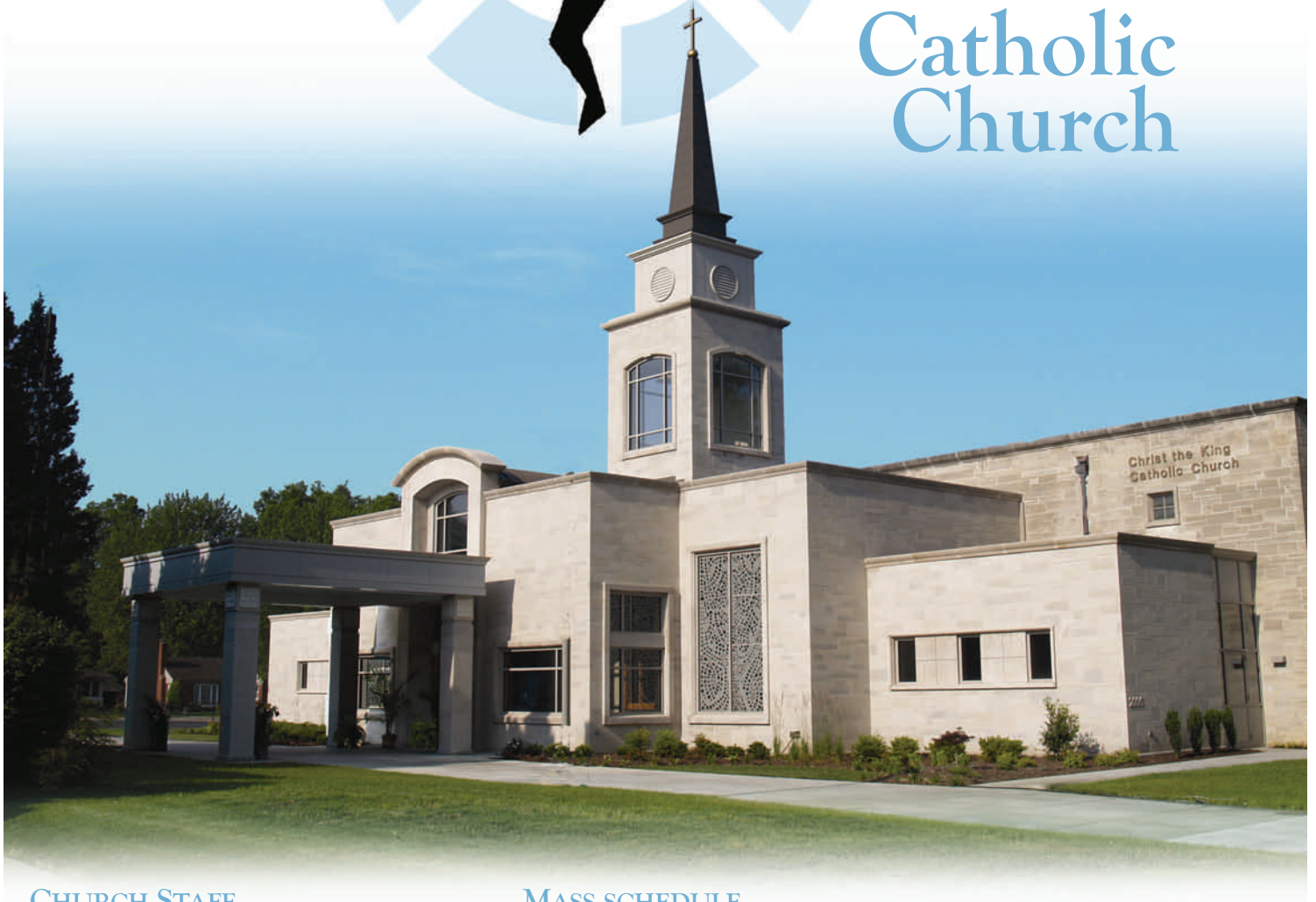

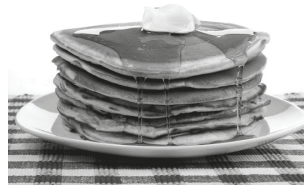

FYI

Private school/home school deduction. This deduction is available for individuals who have a dependent who is enrolled (K-12) in a private school or is home schooled. If the taxpayer incurs any costs for tuition, fees, computer software, textbooks, or school supplies, they are eligible for a \$1,000 deduction per qualifying child. If married filing separately, a dependent may be claimed only once by one parent.

Christian Sharing Fund- Emergency assistance for the needy.

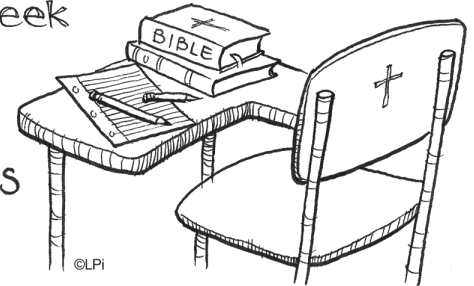
Ministry to the deaf- Religious and liturgical programs and services for hearing impaired.
